



"She Is Dead" (2002)

**Plot Outline:** The film is a musical/melodrama about a pathologist at a big hospital in Stockholm who is secretly in love with a singer.

The film begins with her death being announced at a theatre where the pathologist has gone to see her perform together with some members of a secret society (a bit like the freemasons) that he's a member of. The next morning he finds her dead body when he comes in to work at the morgue. He goes through a crisis, decides not to perform an autopsy on her and replaces her body with another corpse. With the help of the secret society he arranges a private funeral (ending with a cremation) at the societies subterranean lodge. When they are about to cremate her after the ceremony she suddenly comes to life and starts to sing out of the coffin. No one hears her voice except for the pathologist. He tries to stop the cremation but fails and she goes down into the flames singing.

All the dialogue is sung. The format is 2:35 and the film is shot in black and white 35mm. Language: Swedish with English subtitles
